## 1435 – 5.2 Environmental policy statement

### INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

Olleco accepts that it has a responsibility to the principles of sustainability and environmental awareness as summarised by the ISO 14001:2015 standard.

The scope of the organisation is defined as: *‘All activities associated with the supply and storage of fresh cooking oils and the collection, storage, treatment and dispatch of Used Cooking Oils (UCO). The collection of food waste and transport to anaerobic digestion treatment facilities. The conversion of treated UCO into biodiesel and the operation of wastewater and food waste anaerobic digestion treatment plants to generate renewable energy. The receipt, storage and dispatch of hazardous and non-hazardous bulk liquids’.*

### POLICY STATEMENT

Olleco recognises the social and economic importance of protecting the environment; that its commitment to this must encompass all activities and that it should be prepared to lead by example in promoting a sensitive, considered attitude to the environment. - operation of the biodiesel process and storage and dispatch of the biodiesel product
- receipt and de-packaging of food waste and the operation of anaerobic digestion treatment plants to generate renewable electricity and gas
- bulk storage of edible oils.


